

Wish Paper

During Krampa, the people of the White Lands like to make wishes. They do this by using wish paper.

They make paper chimneys and light them and then catch the ash to make their wish.

You can do the same but you will need to do a little detective work. Not all tissue paper works for this, and it's hard to tell which type will or wont work. The best thing to do is to try with a square of all the different types of coloured tissue you have at home or can find in the craft store. Once you've found a type that works you know where to get your supplies. This makes a lovely very low cost extra you can add inside Christmas cards to bring a little extra magic.

Once you have your tissue square get the children (and yourself) to hold the tissue in your hands and think of a wish or intention. Then scrunch the tissue up in a ball. Next, re-open it and wrap it around your finger like a chimney.

Stand you chimney on a plate that's wrapped in foil or on a surface that is not flammable or precious. Then light the chimney from the top. When the ash rises the fire will go out and you can catch the ash to complete your wish making.
