

SCREECHER EGGS.

Edible version

Boil you eggs – white eggs are best. Start in cold water and bring to gentle boil to avoid shells cracking. Once egg is boiled and cooled, light a tea light until it is completely melted. Use small/fine paint brush to paint on deigns using the wax as your paint.

I recommend using an egg cup as a stand.

When design is complete soak the egg in a high concentrate food dye bath.

Once complete place in hot water to melt the wax and wipe clean.

Non edible

Empty your eggs by either blowing or shaking. To do this you need to make two smallish holes in the shell using a pin or a fork prong. For blowing hold your egg over a bowl and blow on the top hole. The pressure should fource the raw egg out of the bottom hole. Once empty you can rinse the egg to remove any left over residue.

To shake the eggs you will need to make the bottom hole bigger. You can then lightly shake the egg which will cause the egg to come out of the hole.

Once your eggs are empty and clean, use felt tip pens or paints or wax-based pencils to create your design. Be as creative as you want!

To Hang: Use half a match or a third of a toothpick, then tie a loop of thread to the middle of the little stick. Push the stick the whole way in the hole, keeping hold of the string. Use string to hang it up.
