

Krampa Cards

The people of the White Lands sometimes sent secret messages and invitations during Krampa.

They used thread to stitch stars on card as a secret symbol that it was a Krampa note.

Below are step by step photos of how to make your own.

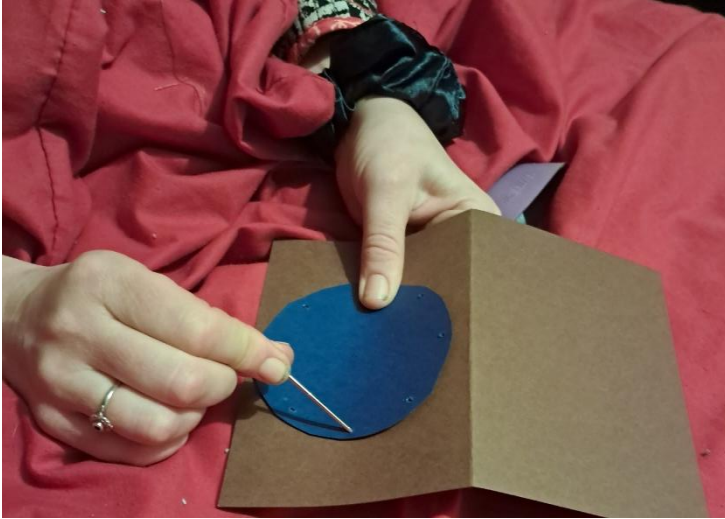
You will need:

- *Card*
- *Embroidery thread and an embroidery needle.*
- *Sticky tape*
- *Scissors*

I will also attach a template for the holes needed.

The pattern to make this star is move clockwise, missing two holes, then anti clockwise, missing one hole. And the pattern repeats until the star is complete.

Step 1: Cut out template and punch holes in the card with a needle.



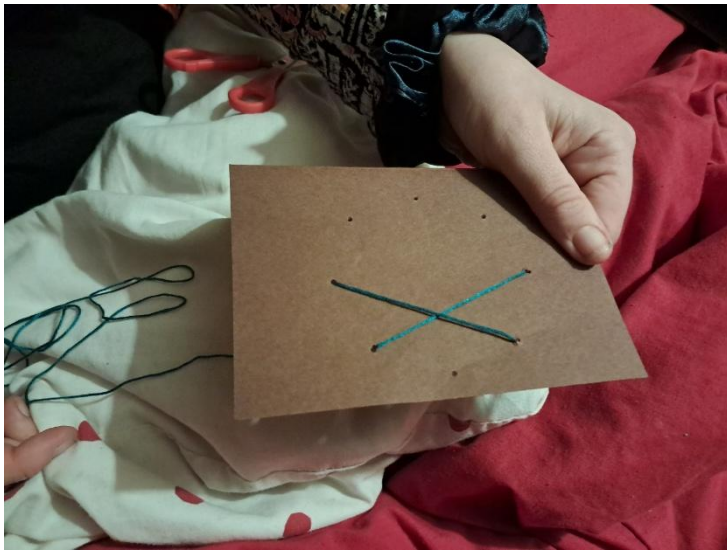
Step 2: Secure the thread with some tape on the back .



Step 3. Miss two holes and then go through the 3rd hole going clockwise



Reverse directions and skip one hole.



Keep going until a star is complete. It should end up looking like this
